The Vernonia Open Air Market is open and ready for summer business! Held every Saturday between June and October from 9am – 1pm, the Open Air Market in downtown Vernonia, Oregon, is bound to have something for everyone. Originally held on Friday evenings, the Market was moved to Saturdays in 2011 due to space constraints and the hope that more people would be able to attend.
