

## **MEGGA EGG HUNT**

On Saturday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, the Columbia County Event Complex (Fairgrounds) hosted its 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Easter Egg Hunt from 9:30am – 1pm. This free event was open to the public with the egg hunts, categorized by age, open to children ages 0-12, starting at 11:00am. The Columbia River Fire and Rescue sounded their engine to begin the hunt itself. In addition to the standard categories of the egg hunt, there were special categories for students aged 0-15 with physical and cognitive challenges.

In addition to the mEGGa Egg Hunt, there was a variety of activities available to visitors including face painting, a 4-H petting zoo, a coloring contest, archery demonstrations, horseback rides, plant-a-seed projects, and a St. Helens High School and 4-H robotics demonstration. Photos with the Easter Bunny were available for \$1 each.

Helping to minimize traffic, Columbia County Rider provided a free shuttle service, transporting eager egg hunters and visitors from St. Helens High School to the fairgrounds. Buses ran every fifteen minutes from 9:15am – 1:00pm.
