



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

For Distance Learning of Arts & Culture in Columbia County

To foster the learning of art and culture in Columbia County during the COVID stay-at-home order, Columbia County Cultural Coalition (CCCC) seeks to sponsor art and cultural activities via video conferencing platforms such as Zoom, Microsoft Teams, or GoToMeeting. A successful proposal will receive a maximum of \$750 to conduct online classes or workshops.

Criteria:

- 1) The class or workshop must benefit people who live in Columbia County.
- 2) The topic must be about art, culture, or heritage.
- 3) The event must serve 15 participants or more.
- 4) The event must be online or via a video conferencing platform.
- 5) The fund can only be used for artist or speaker fees, video conferencing subscription, marketing, or supplies associated with the workshops.
- 6) The funds can only be used for out-of-pocket expenses

Eligibility:

Applicant must be a non-profit organization or a government entity in Columbia County, OR.

Example projects:

- A series of discussions on cultural topic by a library open to public via GoToMeeting.
- A series of drawing or paint along classes for families hosted by a PTO via Zoom.
- Online art classes for members of a non-profit organization.

Timeline:

- Online Application opens: **March 5, 2021**
- Due date for application: **April 20, 2021**
- Final awards to be announced on **April 30, 2021**
- The class or workshop must complete by **September 30, 2021**
